

WASTE PRODUCTION

-22,1% Reduction of waste per bottle between 2021 and 2022 *. 15.566 ton Quantity of processed byproducts reintroduced into the economic system (2021)

ORGANIC AND INTEGRATED PRODUCTION AND BIOLOGICAL CONTROL

4,600 ha vineyards cultivated according to integrated production standards, 5% of which according to organic farming standards.

4,098 ha integrated production (harvest 2022) and 11.88% certified organic and SQNPI (certified integrated production) grapes supplied by the associated winegrowers to the winemaking centres (harvest 2023).

1,236,000 insects released in 1,400 ha of vineyards to fight pests



NATURE ORIENTED AREAS

Production sites of Cantine Riunite & Civ include 18.44% of green areas (2022).

RENEWABLE ENERGY

1,025 MWh in 2023 from renewable energy. The last photovoltaic systems installed in Campagnola started in 2023 (may). The plant has an estimated power of 140 kW. In summer 2024, an additional photovoltaic system (already installed in Campegine with a capacity of 350 kW) will be activated. The company's installed power will then be 1,486 kW

CIRCULAR ECONOMY

13,954 ton by-products reused in circular economy in the wine chain or for energy recovery (2023).

188 ton waste of plastic film (shrink-wrap film) recycled and reused in circular economy (2023)


